Field Experience

A [field experience](#) (3 credits/150 hours of supervised professional work in an approved information environment over the Spring and/or Summer terms) is recommended to students, particularly APRM students, who have had no professional experience and are available in corporate libraries, medical libraries, legal libraries, academic libraries, public libraries, archives, as well as other organizations.

Placement positions allow students the opportunity to apply their learning to a practical work experience. They must be coordinated by a faculty supervisor and a site supervisor who holds the appropriate advanced degree (ex. MLIS).

Goals

1. To offer students an opportunity to extend their academic goals to a practical work experience.
2. To show in concrete terms the work options available to students through an apprenticeship semester that can provide job-related training.
